

# ENTSO-E COOKIE POLICY

## For Users of ENTSO-E New Transparency Platform

### Introduction

This cookie policy explains how ENTSO-E uses cookies on our Transparency Platform <https://newtransparency.entsoe.eu/> (“**Cookie Policy**”).

### What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer or mobile device by websites that you visit. The content of a cookie can only be retrieved or read by the server that creates it. Each cookie is unique to your web browsers or mobile apps. Cookies usually contain identifiers, commonly-used information, and other details. For instance, you can reduce the number of login authentications needed and improve your experience through cookie technology when browsing different pages of our website. Otherwise, you may not be identified as the same person and may be asked to enter the authentication information again if logging on to our website.

These technologies help to better understand user behavior, tell which section of a website have been browsed, and measure and improve the effectiveness of services. We will not use cookies for any purpose other than as described in this Cookie Policy. You can manage or delete cookies based on your own preferences.

### Overview of types of cookies

Different types of cookies can be distinguished:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** - These are cookies that are required for the operation of a website. A website may use cookies to allow you to navigate and use the key features on the site.
- **Analytical/performance cookies** - These cookies allow to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around on a website when they are using it. This helps to improve the way a website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies** - These cookies are used to recognise a user when he or she returns to a website. This enables to personalise content for website visitors – for example, to remember preferences, such as choice of language or region.

The cookies can also be:

- A. **Single session cookies** – These cookies expire at the end of a browser session (usually when a user exits the browser). These cookies allow to recognise and link a user’s actions during a browsing session to ensure that he or she will not be asked for the same information he or she has previously given during a visit to the website. Cookies allow you to proceed through the website quickly and easily without having to authenticate or reprocess each new area a user visits. Cookies may be used to analyse user behaviour, such as which pages have been visited during the session, in order to improve overall experience, for example enabling to determine and display more relevant content.
  
- B. **Persistent cookies** - These cookies are stored on a device in-between browsing sessions. These cookies enable to collect information such as number of visitors to the site and pages visited in order to analyse user behaviour. This information is collected in an anonymous form and will be collated with similar information received from other users to enable us to compile reports in order to develop and improve user experience by displaying more tailored and relevant content.

ENTSO-E currently uses the following cookies on its Transparency Platform website:

Session Context	Necessary cookie	uu.app.bpl	This technically necessary cookie is used to adapt domain names and paths so that a user-friendly URL can be displayed.  The cookie does not store any user data and is only in place for the duration of a session and is deleted at the end of the session.

## How to control cookies
